Annual Meeting of Our Redeemer's Congregation January 29, 2023

President Kristina Wisner called the meeting to order and led with an opening prayer. Mark Karl motioned to approve the agenda; Joe Olson seconded; motion carried.

The Secretary's Report of the 2022 Annual meeting was read by Mary Karl. Darrell Borgen motioned to approve the report, Barb Broten seconded; motion carried.

President's Report Kristina gave acknowledgement to our congregation and to special members for their involvement in serving and activities that had taken place in the past year. She also thanked Barb Broten and Joe Olson for agreeing to fill in the terms of Council members that stepped away in 2022. It's taken the efforts of everyone to keep going this year!

Membership & Pastoral Acts Report was read individually.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed. Total funds (including CDs) \$192,429.01; Total income \$88,0598.30; Total expenses \$54,452.18. Darrell Borgen motioned to approve the report, Mitch Rhen seconded; motioned carried.

The Audit Committee, represented by Darrell Borgen and Karen Janousek, reported that the committee reviewed the financials and that all was in order.

Financial Secretary's Report showed that our number of giving units have remained basically the same over the last 3 years. \$3,361.62 was received as credits towards giving in 2022. Several Items and services were donated without credit request.

Building and Grounds report showed that purchase of new tables and chairs, replacement of the kitchen light fixture and general maintenance was completed in 2022. Projects planned for 2023: prep & paint 1,000 gallon LP tank, purchase new audio equipment for livestream, front door replacement, update landscaping at the base of the bell tower, replace/repair fallen ceiling tiles in basement classroom and consider sale of excess tables and chairs.

Education Committee Report, WOW Treasurer's Report, and WOW Report were reviewed. It was reported that Sonia Foster will no longer be serving as the Treasurer for the WOW account.

O.R. Serving Lists were reviewed. Several opportunities remain for volunteers to serve the congregation.

Old Business:

- Youth Funding Account \$5,000 from the sale of the LOW Bible Camp was deposited in the Youth Group account as directed at the last Annual Meeting.
- Our Redeemer's website Our website, <u>www.ourredeeemersofbadger.org</u>, went live in August 2022. Mary Karl updates the website monthly with calendar events and the newsletter.
- Pastoral vacancy The Call Committee reviewed the application and other materials from an interested candidate in October. They decided that the candidate would not be a good fit for Our Redeemer's and did not pursue the candidate further.

New Business:

• Summer Worship Schedule – A discussion was held on the possibility of changing our worship schedule during the months of June, July and August. Sunday services will remain on the second and fourth Sundays of each month when Pastor Amber is able to lead our service. Wednesday evening services will be held on the first and third weeks of each month with a more informal format.

New Council Member Elections: Mary Karl made a motion, seconded by Diann Hauger, to accept the slate of nominees for the Council: Joe Olson and Jodie Davy; motion carried.

Committee Reviews: Next year's nominating committee will consist of Kristina Wisner, Mitch Rhen and Barb Broten. The remainder of committees were reviewed with the following changes for 2023: Mark Foldesi was added to the Building and Grounds Committee and Barb Broten was added to the Memorial Committee. **2023 Budget:** The 2023 proposed budget was reviewed. Judy Borgen made a motion to increase the line item for the Food Shelf to \$500; seconded by Joe Olson; m/c. A motion to accept the amended proposed budget was made by Mark Karl, seconded by Diann Hauger; motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Rob Wisner, seconded by Mitch Rhen; carried. We closed with the Lord's Prayer.
