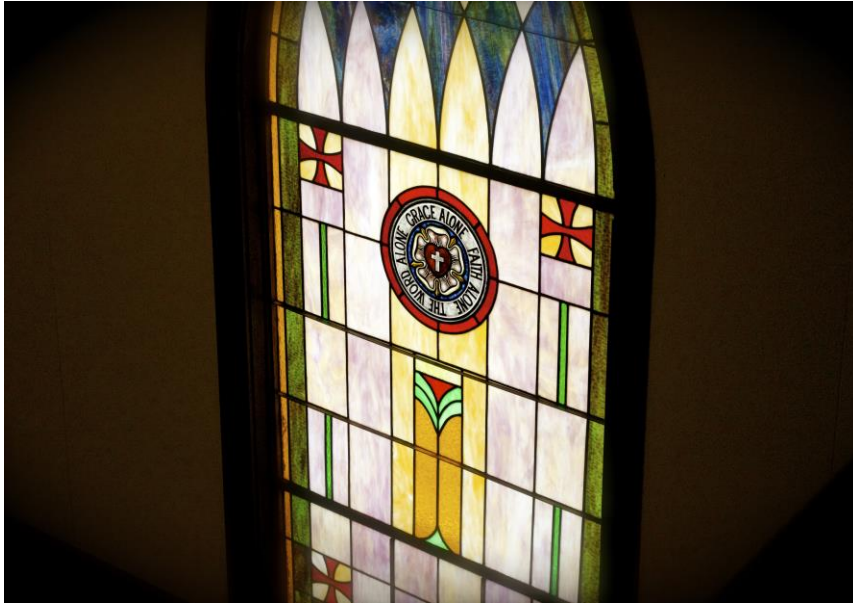

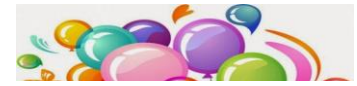

Sunday, May 21, 2023

The meeting was called to order by council president Kristina Wisner. Kristina led us in a devotion.

The agenda was reviewed and approved by Mitch, seconded by Joe – M.C.

The Secretary's report from May was reviewed. Two errors were corrected: Mikael s/b Makil and Shawn s/b Shannon. Joe moved to approve and Chris seconded.MC

The Treasurer's Report was not available. Jodie Randall may be our school contact regarding the Angel Fund.

Building and Grounds:

Old Business:
